Day 01:	Arrival to Kathmandu and transfer to Hotel. Evening briefing about Kailash trip.	Hotel 4star	Transfer to Hotel and brief

Day 08:	Today we have to cover (22km), start very early and the trail leads us rapidly up for few hours to reach Dolma la Pass (5470m). this is the highest point of this journey. While we descending from Dolma la, we will pass alongside a small glacier pool. The legend of the pool is connected with Mata Parvati, continue trek to Zuthulphuk	Guest House	Trek 10-12hrs
Day 09:	Last day of Kailash Parikarma, we need to cover (9km), Morning pack up our gear and move to Darchen, today trail is very easy and flat. It takes about 3hrs to reach Zongdo from here we board to bus and drive back to Darchen, meet our team and drive to Purang / Hilsa.	Himalaya Hotel/ Guest house	Trek 3 hrs and drive 4 hrs
Day 10:	Morning drive to Hilsa border and fly to Simikot - Nepalgunj and afternoon fly to Kathmandu. Evening free	Hotel 4star	By Heli 20min Flight 45min, Flight 55min & Flight 55min

Important Information About Kailash Yatra: we request you to carry at least INR 50000.00 for extra expenses such as extra night's stay at hotel / guest house due to any reasons. Horse ride & porter during Kailash parikrama. Any extra cost incurred there of shall be borne by the clients on the sport. Please keep in mind that Mt. Kailash Yatra is not like an enjoyable holiday tour, therefore you need be prepared to face hardship and unpredictable situations.

Booking and payments

- As per new rules trip booking should be done in advance of 3 months
- 60 days prior to tour departure date, 50% of the total cost should reach Explore Zhang Zhung
- And full payment should made 45 days before departure to Kailash Manasarovar Yatra

Tour Cancellation policy:

- All notice of cancellation must be sent to our office in written.
- Verbal cancellations will not be entertained.
- 21days period from tour departure date 30% cancellation.
- 15 days' period from tour departure date 50% cancellation.
- There will be no refund at all if you cancel the Yatra less than 10 days before the departure date
- Tour operators has fully right to change the dates and cancel the trip if any unavoidable circumstances.

Required Documents for Kailash Yatra Booking:

- Minimum 6 month's valid date passport is required.
- A normal health certificate from your personal doctor to those are 50 years and above by age.
- Age Bar 10-75 years old.
- Scan Passport copy should be reached Firante Treks & Expeditions office, Kathmandu prior 60 days.
- Original Passport should be reached 10 days prior to the yatra at Delhi office

Kailash Yatra Physical Fitness Guide | Firante Treks:

This is one of Earth's toughest high-altitude road journeys. You must be physically fit—no two ways about it.

Patients with asthma or heart problems generally struggle to acclimatize. In your best interest, get examined by your doctor to assess your health and ability to cope with:

- Days of high-altitude travel in 'no-road' conditions.
- Extreme cold and dust.
- Trekking to 18,500 ft during parikrama.

Firante Treks includes acclimatization days for safer journeys.

Clothing's:

As the temperature varies greatly between day and night (from max. 20 degrees Celsius to min. -10 degrees Celsius) one should prepare accordingly.

Altitude Sickness: as you are travelling over high terrain, you are likely to experience symptoms and discomfort of altitude sickness (headache, loss of appetite, nausea, exhaustion, sleeplessness, breathlessness etc.) until your body adjusts to the elevation. this can take a couple of days or more depending on an individual. for this reason alone, we have made it mandatory to stay night at Manasarovar (4600m) moving on to the higher altitudes.

Currency: The unit of Chinese currency is Yuan. USD 1=6.80 & 1 Yuan = INR 12.50 approx.

Money can be exchanged at Nepalgunj, Hilsa and Purang. Exchange all you're remaining Yuan at the end of the trip at Purang before re-entering Nepal.

Bring the following items with you:

Woolen gloves, Balaclava, Sun hat, Thermal wear, Water bottle, Woolen socks, Towel, Light Jacket, Sunglasses, Sun cream, Torch with extra batteries/bulbs, Muffler, Mask, Raincoat, Sweater, Shirt/T-shirt & Trekking shoes

Travel Insurance:

We highly advised to the clients to have full insurance against medical, nature calamity, helicopter evacuation, personal accident and cancelation etc.

Kailash Yatra Cancellation Policy | Firante Treks:

We may cancel your trip due to border closures, permit issues/cancellations by government, war, riots, civil disturbances, strikes, natural disasters, terrorism, airport closures, or similar.

In such cases, we'll notify you ASAP and offer:

- An alternative trip of comparable standard, or
- Refund of payments after deducting actual expenses (flights, visas, permits, hotels, vehicles).

A detailed expense bill will be provided for your insurance claim. Firante holds no further liability.

Note: Chinese authorities may deny entry despite permits if you don't meet their criteria. Never start until permit confirmation.
